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Why “Straight Line Migration”?

Egen’s **2-week Straight Line Migration** is an efficient and cost-effective approach to managing a WebSphere Portal 6.1.5 migration to version 8.X.

At the end of the **2-week** period, we will have uncovered which elements have been migrated successfully, and any that may have failed. In our experience, we have discovered most standard elements are migrated successfully during the **2-week Straight Line Migration**, and therefore complete; but, occasionally issues exist with custom components.

Our **2-week Straight Line Migration** approach will uncover any issues more quickly and therefore be able to resolve any failures in a more cost effective manner for our clients.

Prerequisites

Access Credentials, Key Client Stakeholders’ participation (at least at in the kick-off meeting), and Key Administrative Expertise from the client.

Environment Evaluation Tasks

- 1) Gain access to WebSphere Portal, WebSphere Application Server, and OS administrative
- 2) Obtain Installation Media
- 3) Backup WebSphere Portal 6.1.5 directory structures
- 4) Evaluate and gather WebSphere Portal Security configuration
- 5) Evaluate and gather Database configuration
- 6) Evaluate custom or shared libraries
- 7) Determine inter-portlet communication configuration
- 8) Evaluate Search configuration settings
- 9) Configure VMWare environment for Portal migration
- 10) Evaluate Clustering configuration
- 11) Evaluate Port/Context settings
- 12) Evaluate Custom Themes/Skins
- 13) Backup databases

Pre-migration Tasks

- 1) Install recommended fix packs
- 2) Install WebSphere Portal 8 development environment
- 3) Create Portal Server and Deployment Manager augmented profiles
- 4) Install WebSphere Portal 8 fix packs
- 5) Configure LDAP
- 6) Configure DB2
- 7) Disable search indexing tasks
- 8) Remove obsolete Portlets
- 9) Perform cleanup of unused artifacts, pages, content

Portlet, Theme, and Shared Artifacts

- 1) Copy shared libraries to new environment
- 2) Copy portlet WARs
- 3) Update context specific references in the theme
- 4) Modify context URI



Execute Migration Commands

- 1) Execute the WASPreUpgrade tasks with all tracing enabled
- 2) Create wp_profile for Portal 8
- 3) Execute WASPostUpgrade tasks
- 4) Execute UpgradeConfigEngine tasks
- 5) Execute Database update tasks
- 6) Execute upgrade profile commands

Web Content Management Migration

- 1) Remove locks on all content items
- 2) Convert NLS strings
- 3) Increase transaction log, descriptor limits, size
- 4) Perform additional migration tasks

Validate and Troubleshoot Migration

- 1) Start WebSphere Portal
- 2) Execute validation scripts
- 3) Execute scripts to deploy new WebSphere Portal 8 functionality in migrated environment
- 4) Re-enable services
